Planner's comments - George Rose

Due to the conditions every course was testing, the mud at times was deeper than some of those competitors on the Yellow and Orange courses. It was good to see the number of people opting to do the Score course, although the Norwegian course only attracted two. I don't know whether both of them were caught out by the little concentration test of two controls on one bit of map.

Controller's comments - Rob McKenna

It is difficult to comment on winning times with so few competitors, although in general the colour coded courses do appear to be a bit too long. This could also have been due to the difficult conditions underfoot made worse by the constant use of the wood by off road vehicles. When off the main tracks, there are some nice areas of the wood, which are quite technical in places and I believe that George made best use of these.

Apologies to those competitors on the score event who were inconvenienced by the mis-match of written control descriptions to that marked on the map. This one slipped through the pre-event checking. Also to competitors on the Norwegian who came across two legs marked on one map - I didn't spot this until checking controls on the day.
