Controller's comments - Tricia Davies

Fontburn always presents the planner with a number of challenges. These include how to make the junior courses short and easy enough whilst keeping them interesting and varied. I was a bit concerned about the length of the yellow course, but felt it was compensated for by the fact that juniors actually saw a different part of the area for a change. Most juniors seemed to enjoy themselves even though some competitors times inevitably proved to be rather long.

Longer courses are difficult to plan from a technical point of view in an area which has an over-abundance of obvious line features. In addition, having to go round the reservoir restricts the variation of courses which can be planned from one event to another. As a result, they were perhaps too easy (I do not apologise for the platform on the brown course which moved to an adjacent spur! Most of you were too polite to complain!).

Nevertheless, I hope everyone enjoyed their run and appreciated the weather - it is December after all and we had visited the area in blizzards just a fornight before.
