### Controllers comments - Dick Whitworth.

My apologies for not checking out the state of the swollen stream before the competition started - amongst other things, I was worried about the car park. Late on the afternoon it was just the usual benign stream it had been on every previous visit from the event officials and when I got back home on the Sunday evening it was obvious that there had been no rain at all over the whole weekend in Carlisle, just 80 miles away.

Most, if not all, of the late starters heard variations on un-crossable river, voided courses, etc., and 45% of all competitors attempting courses that crossed the stream, retired at some stage. I therefore feel I have to make these courses non-competitive and badge times, estimated in several cases, have only been awarded to the classes on the remaining 11 shorter courses.

On behalf of all the competitors, I would like to thank the hard working NN officials and in particular the two main officials - mapper / planner Dave Caudwell and organiser Rob McKenna, both of whom it was a pleasure to work with.

### Organisers comments – Rob McKenna.

What a weekend, it seemed that everything had conspired against us for this event. Some 18 months ago, when the event was first conceived and I agreed to organise, it seemed to be an event held at a reasonable time of the year and on a good (by North East standards) area. All the initial indications were that this would be a successful event. Firstly we were approached by the Major Event Panel with a proposal that the event be put forward to the IOF as one of the three BOF events to be considered as part of the IOF World Ranking series. Although we pointed out that the terrain was not of 'Lake district' standard, we were assured that the 'elite' were aware of this and wanted an event at this time of the year. Preparations went ahead on this basis. Not long after we discovered that there was a clash with a proposed badge event to be held in the West Midlands and a formal protest was put forward through the NEOA fixtures secretary to the fixtures committee. Subsequently, that badge event was to be considered as the venue for a Future Champions Cup match, which would draw on the M/W18-20 year olds. We were told that the Future Champions Cup needed a round in the Midlands so as to cut down the travelling for the juniors (apparently the North has an abundance of such fixtures) and that Cannock Chase would offer better orienteering for this type of match. Unfortunately the UK Cup tends to follow the Future Champions Cup and this draws on the M/W21E competitors. This made the staging of not only a National Event, but also a World ranking event at Bewick a nonsense and BOF had got itself into a seemingly un-retractable situation. To make matters worse, there was a badge event in the South East as well as colour coded events in Scotland, East Anglia, the South West and the Cannock Chase event was to be used as a selection race for entry to the Junior squad training camps. Given that it is difficult at the best of times to attract competitors to the North East, this had left our National event out on a limb. This was reminiscent of the last National event held on the area two years ago, when again there was a clash with an event in the Midlands and BOF had arranged a Junior training weekend in the Lakes. Whilst there appears to be sympathies all round from other clubs, BOF's proposal to offset some of the losses may help to alleviate the financial burden on our small club, but the damage done as regards the relationship between BOF and its members will be harder to repair. In any case, financial rewards are not what people expect - there is a lot of satisfaction to be gained from staging a 'successful' event knowing that competitors have appreciated the efforts of all those involved. I personally have lost confidence in the workings of BOF and its committees.

There has been a lot of pressure put on the event and I have had a number of sleepless nights preparing for it. The weather leading up to the competition had been both cold and wet, but plans had been made to suit these conditions. The car parking area was usually well drained and had a good surface to drive on when wet; the start, finish and assembly areas were all within close proximity of each other; control descriptions had been sent out in advance. But nothing had prepared us for the deluge that happened that Sunday. The first problem was the 'ford' at the bottom of the bank. This was passable at 8.00am but the worry was, that if the rain continued then we would not get competitors out of the competition area. A decision was taken to warn people of the danger, suggest parking in the village and to put the starts back 30 minutes. The delay in coming to this decision had a knock on effect in the setting up of other areas - re-organising the start, re-arranging suitable parking for those attempting to cross the ford. In the ensuing bad weather some points of the organisation had got left out - start lists, control descriptions, suitable warning and direction signs and in the end, on the day results. Early comments on the event were sympathetic to the situation, with some thanking us for an exhilarating run. Personally, after hearing some of the comments of the earlier finishers I was amazed that people were still attempting to cross the stream. I would like to thank all the club members who valiantly helped out on the day without question or complaint, to Dave for producing another excellent map and planning well received courses and to Dick for patiently keeping both myself and Dave on the right side of the rules and also Tim for controlling a somewhat depleted elite course. But most of all thanks to all of the competitors who supported the event and turned up to endure those horrendous conditions.

I have had a request from a lady competitor who was stranded by the stream and would like to thank a young man (Steven Chapman) for coming to her rescue – in the rescue bid he lost his card and had to forfeit his run.

### Planner Comments - Dave Caudwell.

When I collected in the controls in bright sunshine on the Wednesday following the event (it had rained most of Monday and Tuesday), I crossed and re-crossed the Harehope burn without getting my feet wet – it was difficult to comprehend the very real problems competitors had experienced only three days previous in crossing this stream. Having drawn the map for the event, I have spent more than a year on this project and my sense of frustration in not being able to see how the map and my courses stood up to your scrutiny makes me wonder how worthwhile the whole thing has been. Because of the weather on this one weekend, National Event 3 was ruined. Never before have I seen the stream in an uncrossable state – and I also drew the map for Bewick Moor North. What have I done to deserve this?

On a more encouraging note, I was at the finish and listened to your comments as you handed in your control cards. Despite being cold, very wet (and in some cases having come close to being drowned), you almost all found something pleasant to say about one or more of the area, the map, the courses, your experiences or the organisational team – so for that I thank you for that. I think you all deserve championship badges for turning out at all.
