**Organisers comments – Ruth and Grahame Rose**

Thank you all for turning up and supporting this event. The competition day was blessed with reasonably fine weather, which helped to create a good atmosphere amongst the few competitors who turned out and in general enjoyed their runs. The organisation seemed to run smoothly with no reported complaints and thanks must go to the dedicated small band of club helpers. The crossing of out of bounds areas for whatever reason does jeopardise our future use of the area and competitors must not make their own decision on this without knowing the full facts.

**Planners comments – Julian Warren.**

I really enjoyed planning this event in what must arguably be one of the most beautiful woods in the north east, and I think that from listening to most people's comments on the finish line that they also enjoyed their runs. Apologies to those on course 6, who may have been inconvenienced by control 6 being wrong – this was an error which crept in during overprinting. Finally, I was disturbed to hear several reports of people who flagrantly ignored clearly marked out of bounds areas, even when this was pointed out to them by fellow competitors. Compliance with any out of bound ruling is not optional.

**Controllers comments – Paul Taylor (CLOK).**

Well done NN for organising this enjoyable event, including the friendly forest and the perfect running weather. Special mention should be made to Julian for planning the courses – a difficult job considering the limited possibilities, but he performed it admirably. Also to Rob McKenna for all his work behind the scenes, including the printing of the maps. Sincere apologies to competitors on course 6, of which about 5 of you ran with a flawed map. The mistake, an incorrectly located circle, had been spotted and corrected, but some incorrect ones found their way into the bag. The affected competitors have been very gracious and have not forced us to void the course. I hope this error didn't spoil their run too much, even though they must have lost a little time. None have been disqualified for punching the control in the circle.

As an explanation of the course combinations, we had used the BOF guidelines to combine as many courses as possible, based on the entry at recent badge events in the NEOA. This may seem to produce some uncommon combinations and some competitors running unusual distances, but the winning times were within BOF recommendations in nearly all cases.

**Printing details – Rob McKenna**

The maps were printed on an HP1120C printer using OCAD5 software running on a Pentium I (200MHz) computer with 64 MB of ram and took approximately 3.25 minutes per map. There were some 330 maps printed and only 258 maps used (courses 1-3 had a map exchange) – total ideal printing time 18 hours. Numbers were based on the recent event at Slaley plus pre-entries received a week before the event, which gave an estimated total badge entry of 186.
