**Planner comments - Gary Russell**

I took over the planning role from Rob fairly late, when the club struggled to get a suitable controller for the event. Work commitments and some recent health issues have hampered my progress with the planning procedure. My thanks to the small band of club helpers who stayed behind to make control collection a lot easier.

**Controllers comments - Rob McKenna**

In general the winning times look about right given the warm conditions on the day. There were some tired and de-hydrated looking competitors at the finish but some favourable comments were given. However competitors on the Short Green course seem to have suffered unduly for some reason. In retrospect, the Blue course could also have done with being about 1 km shorter.

It is difficult to avoid the heather and I had thought that competitors may have benefitted from a 'heather screen' to make a more informed route choice - but time constraints meant that it couldn't be done for this event.

The late appearance of a number of sheep pens, some very close to a few of the controls took me by surprise when I was checking controls - they were not there when checking control sites a week or so ago - sorry if these detracted from the enjoyment of your run.

BO members are eligible for a Navigation Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses at the same Technical Difficulty (TD) standard. The certificates are 'star' based e.g. 1 star for TD 1 up to 5 Star for TD 5.

**The Racing Challenge**

BO members are also eligible for a Racing Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses (of the same TD) within the following times.

Gold award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 12.5 mins  
Silver award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 15 mins  
Bronze award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 20 mins
