Many thanks for all turning up and supporting this event and I hope the weather did not dampen your spirits too much.

This was my first attempt at planning a full colour coded event and I hope you all enjoyed the courses I set. My thanks to Andrew for his patience and guidance through the planning stages and control setting.

Comments relayed at the finish regarding both the area and courses were favourable, which certainly makes all the days of hard work worth it. The area is challenging from both a planning and competitive point of view. The wealth of detail on the spoil heaps called for careful selection of control sites to ensure that the correct feature could be located within the circle. From a competitors viewpoint, there were areas of intense concentration followed by some hard running then more concentration and I hope I got the balance right.

Problems with parking and the need to plan a technically easy yellow course generally dictated the start and finish areas. Crossing points seemed to interrupt the flow of most of the courses, but this is very difficult to avoid given the nature of the area.

I must mention the excellent work done by Maurice Swales and David Brook in surveying the area and to Dave Caudwell for producing an excellent base map and for overprinting the courses. This was the second version of the map, but there still remain a few areas that need to be fine tuned. The main problem being the amount of detail in these areas, so what to leave out, what to show and how. The area has a lot of potential, particularly if electronic punching were to be used and hopefully next time.
