Controllers comments – Maurice Swales

Firstly, our thanks to Gateshead MBC for allowing us to stage an orienteering event at the Riverside Park, with special thanks to Mr.David Bunce of the stadium for his help and guidance. Secondly, a large thank you to all of those who took part, over 120 of you made all our efforts worth while. Thirdly, but by no means least, my sincere thanks to all those who helped, especially the organisers David White and Nick Glover, the team leaders Pat Major, John Moore, Graham Rose and Russ Snowdon, not forgetting the planner Phil Richards. I trust that Phil learnt a great deal about orienteering from his considerable efforts. His main problem was the small size of the area, another being the possibility of uninvited guests. In my opinion he overcame the first well. He would have preferred slightly longer courses but the results agree fairly well with BOF rules, the fast conditions contributing to fast winning times. I would have preferred to see fewer people retire. No controls were taken although the one at the earth wall north end was moved, perhaps the presence of people dismantling the cross country courses deterred them. Several people questioned the accuracy of the master maps but in all cases it turned out to be copying errors by competitors, due to the size of the map or the presence of similar features? A generous approach was taken towards those competitors who did not realise that in a score event you should punch in the box which corresponds to the control number.
