I felt that Craig produced very good courses, using a variety of control sites and weaving them together well. It is a great shame that the event took place on the only wet day in an otherwise dry fortnight, the same amount of preparation and commitment must be made whether 50 or 150 people take part. Competitors coped well with writing the letters onto their control cards, problems occurred with controls 70 (path junction) and 69 (fence corner); 63 (path bend) and 64 (veg boundary, E edge), both pairs being in close proximity to each other. Special thanks to COG (Conyers Orienteering Group) for boosting the numbers – my regards to any of the staff who remember me from 30 years ago!
