### Planner's comments - Nick Lord

Although this was the first time I had planned a badge event I did not expect too many problems as I felt I knew Chopwell pretty well (so do a great many others unfortunately!). There were still some corrections needed even to the latest revision of the map; rather too many line features for technically difficult courses; a fair amount of bramble (we had no snow this winter to squash them down); and above all vandals who wished to increase their collection of NN punches. On the whole I received a good number of favourable comments about the courses and very few complaints which makes it all worthwhile.

I must thank Tricia Davies for her hard work - assistant planners are a boon in an event of this complexity and John Crosby for his calm approach to all the headaches that cropped up.

## Assistant planner's comments - Tricia davies

This was my first attempt at planning a 'real' event and I found the experience both interesting and most enjoyable. In planning the junior and colour coded courses, I hope I managed to get the right balance - making them interesting enough without being too difficult. Most people I spoke to seemed to enjoy themselves.

One small controversy did arise over the Yellow course. Before the event it was suggested that it might be too easy, but we let it stand as I think the main aim is for younger children (and newcomers) to complete the course and feel they have achieved something by doing so. On the day, however, some felt that the course was too difficult! May I point out that the Yellow course was also the M10, W10 and W11 course - a common combination at badge events. I question, therefore, whether children younger than this should be doing such a course completely on their own.

I would like to thank Nick for his help and advice, as well as all the people who collected the controls after the event, making our job much easier at the end.

# Controller's comments - John Crosby

The only comment I would like to make is about control 78. There were doubts in my mind from the start but the feature checked out in relation to features to the north east. It was not until the final check on Sunday morning that I realised that the fence to the south was 100m out. I hope it did not spoil your runs too much and hope that most of you copied the correction down.
