We hope you enjoyed the first O-event held in the Bishop's Park, appropriately on Palm Sunday, and perhaps even had the time to admire the 18th century deer shelter as you sped to the finish. We have to thank the Bishop of Durham for his help in securing the use of this small but very attractive area for orienteering; our first request to the agents for permission was turned down. What the area lacks in size it more than makes up for in variety and detail, and Julian Birkinshaw's map does it ample justice.

It was pleasing to welcome a fair number of newcomers to the sport; we hope that their experience will make them want to come to future events in the north east (see date and addresses at end). The string course was an innovation and seems to have been enthusiastically received by children (youngest 1½ years old) and parents alike; we hope it will become a regular feature of events in the region.

Our aim of ensuring maximum success, especially for inexperienced competitors, was achieved with only six disqualifications out of about 150 participants.

It was good to see some of the younger competitors, as well as those of more mature years, running with such determination though discreet observation of the techniques of several youngsters suggested that they would be well advised to keep their compass in their pockets and rely more on relating the map to the surrounding features.

What tidy and considerate people you are; when we left the area at 3pm it was difficult to believe that some 200 people had been there earlier in the day. This will greatly help our efforts to obtain permission for future events in The Bishop's park.
