The Navigation Challenge

BO members are eligible for a Navigation Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses at the same Technical Difficulty (TD) standard. The certificates are 'star' based e.g. 1 star for TD 1 up to 5 Star for TD 5.

The Racing Challenge

BO members are also eligible for a Racing Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses (of the same TD) within the following times.

Gold award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 12.5 mins Silver award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 15 mins Bronze award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 20 mins

The certificates will be automatically generated via the results that clubs have uploaded into the BO website. They will be available for you to download via the members area of the BO website.

Controller's comments - Rob McKenna

There was a problem with controls 167 and 180, which affected the Blue, L.Green and Orange courses. This was not brought to my attention until the first competitors arrived at download. The mistake was totally my fault, although I still can not get my head round how it may have happened. There were two controls involved which affected three of the courses and in short, control 167 was where control 180 should have been and vice versa. I can possibly understand making the mistake at the first control but would have thought that when I came to the other control I should have noticed that I didn't have that number and alarm bells should have rung. However, once spotted, the controls where switched but this wasn't until fairly well into the event - I think after 12.00. Thanks to Pippa Archer for help during this switch. www.northern-navigators.org.uk/results/260114map.pdf Having had a quick look over the splits results it appears that some competitors may have lost about 10 minutes at the control. Unfortunately it would be unfair to adjust individual times, but if anybody feels really aggrieved then the courses will have to be voided. It is difficult to estimate time lost by any competitor on any control, as only they would know what had actually happened. Some of the more experienced orienteers may have arrived at the control, knowing they were in the right place and probably not checked the number (particularly with touch free), so may have lost little or no time. However, the correct approach if you are ever unsure of your location is that you should always check the control number – normally it will correspond to the one on your map.

This situation is really inexcusable and should not have happened. There may be many reasons why it did happen but I cannot apologise enough for the error and can only think that the weather must have affected my reasoning at the time.
