Well done to David Sprot, putting in another good performance, though not quite getting all the controls this time.

For those who are interested his route was as follows:

11,8,12,13,16,17,20,21,22,23,19,18,15,14,27,24,26,25,30,29,28,3,2,1,4,5,6,7,10

only missing out on number 9, which works out at about 9.1km with over 300m of climb. He thought that getting them all was achievable and only poor route choice hampered his final efforts near the end. However, his older brother Michael did get them all but had a lot more time penalties.
