Apologies also for a few of the controls not working due to battery failure. For future reference I have been informed that the kit is to be updated in the new year to the newer ('Professional') version of EMIT control. They are a physically different type of control being much larger and although they work in a similar way you don't have to be as close and can pass them faster if your able. However, unlike the 'old' kit, battery life can be monitored so controls should be more reliable.

Aykley Heads does have a lot of potential with possible expansion to the north into the Newton Hall housing estate, eastwards across the railway and back into Wharton Park, above Durham railway station. The only problem may be finding a suitable date when parking would not be an issue.
