# Organiser's comments - $Bob\ Cooper$

Thanks to NN members and families for their help in making today's event so successful. Competitors I spoke with all said how enjoyable they found the event and I heard no adverse comments from anybody. Thanks also to Mr.Robson and Mr.Leiper for their help and allowing us to use the area for this event.

## Planner's comments - Rob McKenna

There are a few problems when planning at Shaftoe – getting the right mix of technicality and distance applies to most of the courses. The crossing points also provide a hindrance.

The start was determined by where the yellow course could go and although on paper the course looked quite easy, I hope they found venturing onto the moor among the crags and marshes a bit of an adventure.

There is plenty of detail for the mid courses and fitting them round the crossing points was the only problem.

The longer courses had a few controls on the rocky slope to the south, which may have seemed a little easy. I think that there is a lot of rock detail not shown on the map, basically because there is too much to show. Hence only the larger boulders and crags are shown with varying size of symbol to signify their magnitude. When you first encounter the

area it is difficult at race speed to determine what has been mapped. I did remove the tags from the crags in an attempt to clarify the map and I hope this helped. I think that this area needs to be re-visited to make it more usable in the future.

On a good day Shaftoe Crags is a delight to plan on and run round and I think that the weather on Sunday, although cold in the wind, was near perfect for the event. I hope you enjoyed your runs.

Thanks to Dave Brook for his guidance and marshalling one of the

gates leading out of the start field.
