Planners comments – *John Maguire and John Willis*

We began planning the courses by looking for a start and finish sheltered from the elements, which also gave access to suitable junior courses. We wanted courses that were reasonably consistent in terrain, so we kept to the moor.

The Common is never going to give technically demanding orienteering but most people seemed to enjoy their runs – and said so, for which we are very grateful. We tried to make sure that controls were not too visible and, with longer legs, ensure that some navigational skills were needed. Courses were on the long side, but winners times were in the range expected. There were some comments which will help us improve next time and others that we would enjoy discussing. We could not, however, argue with course F displaying an incorrect control number in the assembly area. Although coreect on the map, there was still the possibility of confusion and we apologise for this. There was also differences with punches removed (eg control 298). I hope that we responded quickly enough to ensure that runs were not disrupted.

This was our first event of this size. If we have learnt anything, it is that you cannot start early enough; there is never enough time.

We owe a sincere debt of gratitude to Bill Hodgson, the controller. He was always good humoured and tolerant in the face of much provocation and guided us gently but firmly out of the problems our inexperience created.

Controllers comments – *Bill Hodgson (CLOK)*

Apologies to competitors who lost time on course F because the 'blow-up' of the course description list had not had control 9's number altered from 272 to 276 – although the number had been altered on the maps description list. We should also have had information displayed as to which map scale the various courses were, as, in some cases the description list was stuck over the scale on the map.

Most comments that I heard were complementary and the two John's must be congratulated for their efforts in their first badge event. Thanks must go to Elizabeth and David for their most efficient organising.
