The Navigation Challenge.

BO members are eligible for a Navigation Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses at the same Technical Difficulty (TD) standard. The certificates are 'star' based e.g. 1 star for TD 1 up to 5 Star for TD 5.

The Racing Challenge.

BO members are also eligible for a Racing Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses (of the same TD) within the following times.

- Gold award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 12.5 mins
- Silver award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 15 mins
- Bronze award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 20 mins

Planner's Comments - Rob McKenna

Hope you all enjoyed the courses and the weather, although it may have been a bit too warm for running. The area can be very fast but as the grass had not been cut on the airfield this may have slowed some down. The undergrowth in the small wooded sections was also a bit tough and nettly in places so sorry about that.
Getting permission for access to check things is a bit awkward with the land belonging to the MOD, so although many of the control sites on the airfield had been used before I didn't really see them until control setting, otherwise I may have moved a few of them.
There were two controls that a few competitors reported having problems with - 033 (pit) and 054 (thicket). The first was in a rather nettly area and apparently there may have been another un-mapped pit in close proximity - I will have to check this for next time. The second was in an area with a few other un-mapped thickets of similar size, although I feel sure that the control was on the correct one.
It would seem that the shorter courses that stayed on the airfield found the going a bit tough and in retrospect it may have been better having them in the Barracks area. The problem here is that there are safety issues for younger competitors with traffic in the Barracks.
The Brown course was won in a fairly fast time and a few commented that the distance was not right - I have double checked this and it is correct. I did think that an extra 1km should have been added but this couldn't have been done in the Barracks without going over the same ground and I did not think that competitors would relish the extra distance on the airfield. Unfortunately, there were also restrictions on the use of the Barracks area - with it being a Sunday the married quarters area to the south and south west had to be out of bounds.
