Organisers comments - Boris Spence

Many thanks to all competitors for supporting this event on what started out as a brisk winters day, but got out quite pleasant as the event finished. Apart from the queues at registration and a few initial problems with 'dead' E-tags things seemed to be going well. The number of competitors who turned up caught us out a bit and a strain was put on the number of maps printed. Fortunately a few competitors agreed to us re-cycling their map which helped us out of a rather embarrassing situation and we are grateful to them for that. Replacement electronic copies of those maps have been sent out, but if anybody has been missed then please let Rob McKenna know and he will forward one to you.

Apologies to one competitor whose E-tag failed part way round her course, we have taken her overall time but no splits were available to be published.

Many thanks to Mr.Robson (East Shaftoe) and Mr.Leiper (Middleton Bank Top) for their assistance in allowing us to use the area for this event.

Planner / controller comments - Rob McKenna

Many thanks for some of the kind comments I overheard at download - it appears that most competitors enjoyed their runs.

As is usual, the planning revolved around where the Yellow course could go and to give them a change I decided to have the start going straight onto the moor - this allowed the Yellow to have a fairly easy loop round the moor and back to their finish. It also meant that most of the other courses could head for the rocky, steep slope of Shaftoe Crags. I didn't use the parking field nor the field leading up to the start as sometimes it can be just be dead running, but unfortunately to get the distance on the longer courses meant going back and forth almost over the same ground, albeit a different direction. There are plenty of features on that southern hill so I hope that it was still a challenge. The steep slopes of Shaftoe can be rather demanding especially with the wet, dead bracken which is why I kept the older competitors to the edge of it. I did hear one adverse comment with regard to one of the courses having to go down to control 184 (re-entrant) and back up again - the shape of the course made it difficult to do otherwise with the controls available. I could have possibly used one of the higher boulders, but most of the larger boulders on the slope are quite distinctive.

Shaftoe Crags although quite small, is a gem of an area providing good running with a moderate technical challenge - I do hope that you enjoyed your runs.

Map printing is always a bit of a problem when trying to estimate numbers of competitors that may turn up - 115 maps were printed which was based on the last few events at Shaftoe, our last two NEOL events and also the CLOK NEOL event at Silton. Apart from the Yellow and Orange courses all the maps were used - this is unusual for one of our events. Re-cycling maps is not something that I prefer and I am grateful to those competitors who allowed us to re-use their map.

Just a note on the British Orienteering membership number - firstly if you have your number at hand it does speed up registration, but secondly, when the results are submitted to the BO website those numbers help to declare a members status for gaining ranking points and other incentive schemes. I do try to fill in the blanks where possible, but for members from outside the NEOA this becomes quite a task and is sometimes impossible.

North East Orienteering League (NEOL)

The Navigation Challenge

BO members are eligible for a Navigation Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses at the same Technical Difficulty (TD) standard. The certificates are 'star' based e.g. 1 star for TD 1 up to 5 Star for TD 5.

The Racing Challenge

BO members are also eligible for a Racing Challenge certificate after successfully completing 3 colour coded courses (of the same TD) within the following times.

Gold award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 12.5 mins

Silver award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 15 mins

Bronze award - Participants time < Course length (km) x 20 mins

The certificates will be automatically generated via the results that clubs have uploaded into the BO website. They will be available for you to download via the members area of the BO website.
