Controller's comments - Rob McKenna

Only a few weeks ago it was feared that this event and possibly all future events at Bewick Moor may not go ahead after it was discovered that SSSI status had been imposed on the whole of the area. But, after viewing our provisional courses, Natural England did sanction this event only on the proviso that we had an exclusion zone aound an area that had a pair of nesting peregrine falcons. This meant re-planning the two longer courses, at short notice, to avoid the crags to the north of the map. Parts of Bewick are very pleasant to run over at this time of the year, but unfortunately the area around the start does have some patches of heavy going heather. This is a bit unavoidable as the start is dependent on suitable line features for the juniors. Courses and controls were planned to avoid most of the heather where possible.

A lot of hard work has gone into putting this event on and it's a pity more people hadn't turned up to sample Bewick Moor at probably the best time of the year. The weather turned out to be almost perfect, and the threatened showers were fairly light early on. It did get out warm and sunny when collecting controls in. We hope you all enjoyed your runs even though it may have been a little tough going at times. Many thanks to Bob Cooper and Kath Ivens for parking, David & Sheila Brook at the start, Phil Batts and Lorraine Porter for manning the computer.
