**Organisers comments (Day 1)**

This event seemed fraught with problems from the outset. Firstly, day 2 was originally planned to be at Housesteads, but following the Foot and Mouth outbreak, one of the farmers on the area had re-stocked with a herd of Highland cattle. Apparently they had been quite flighty - having already escaped once from the fields and causing havoc on the nearby roads. Whilst, in general, he was happy to have us use the land, he felt it better to leave it for a year or so to let the cattle settle in. Frantic efforts were made to find another area and after a lot of hard work done by Dave Caudwell, the Hamsterley Forest map was produced and Dryderdale map updated. This had been done in record time and was not without its problems, so many thanks to Dave. Secondly, the original entries secretary was involved with moving house and could not fulfil this role - I agreed to take over, but would not be able to carry out all of the organiser's responsibilities. A mix up with BOF meant that mis-information about the event had been advertised in older fixture lists and even in the current list, contact details had been mis-represented. Apologies to those that were unable to contact me before the event.

In taking over the role of entries secretary, the bulk of pre-event organising fell to Don Smith, who had stepped in to act as co-ordinator. He worked tirelessly to ensure the smooth running of the event - much of this unseen by competitors and other officials. For one reason or another, results processing and display continues to be a problem with the club at the moment. Continuing improvements in the sport seem to have left us somewhat behind in the technology stakes. The region has applied for a grant towards purchasing electronic punching but has been unsuccessful in its bid for the moment.

Our thanks must go to the Forestry Commission for the use of the area and help during the planning and organising stages, in particular Robin Lofthouse and his assistant Michael McDonnell. Thanks also to the Carole Atkinson of West Hoppyland Trekking Centre for access to the day 2 red start.

The areas used for assembly and parking on both days seemed to be ideal and worked well on the day, being compact and generally local to all amenities.
